

Configuration of MDofficeMail Email Account on Android OS

Please follow these steps:

- 1. Go to Settings > Accounts > New Account.
- 2. Select "Email", Enter your email address and password, click Next



3. Select POP or IMAP which ever necessary.



- 4. Enter full email id in Username and password. Your email address (ex: name@domain.com)
- 5. Tap where it says "POP Mail Server" or "IMAP Mai I Server" and enter "mail.mdofficemail.com."
- 6. Security type should be selected as "**SSL**" from drop down.
- 7. Incoming port should be Port: 993 for IMAP and 995 for POP
- 8. Click on **NEXT.**
