

Configuration of MDOfficeMail Email Account on Android OS

Please follow these steps:

1. Go to Settings > Accounts > New Account.
2. Select "Email", Enter your email address and password, click Next



3. Select POP or IMAP which ever necessary.



4. Enter full email id in Username and password. Your email address (ex: name@domain.com)
5. Tap where it says "POP Mail Server" or "IMAP Mail Server" and enter "mail.mdofficemail.com."
6. Security type should be selected as "SSL" from drop down.
7. Incoming port should be **Port: 993** for **IMAP** and **995** for **POP**
8. Click on **NEXT**.


